Entering a Rental Assistance End Date-HMIS Job Aid

Rapid Rehousing is an intervention-informed, Housing First approach that rapidly connects families and individuals experiencing homelessness to permanent housing through a tailored package of assistance that may include the use of time-limited financial assistance and targeted supportive services.

If a household has maxed out their RRH or Penn Free Bridge RRH funding, the project must enter the Rental Assistance End Date.

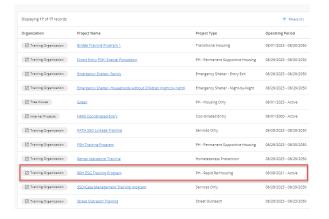
If the household wishes to exit the project at this time, the provider should complete exit assessments on all household members. If the project wishes to remain I the project to receive targeted case management after rental assistance is maxed out, they should remain enrolled until their exit from the project.

Entering Rental Assistance End Date

Log into HMIS and select the *Projects* hyperlink on the upper right screen.

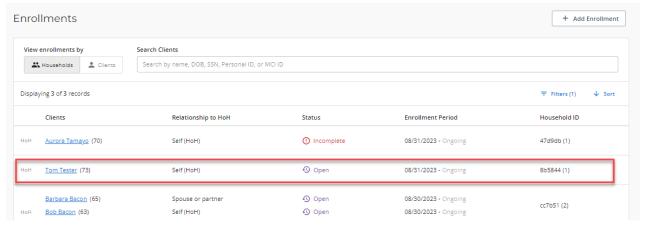


Select the RRH or Penn Free Bridge RRH project.

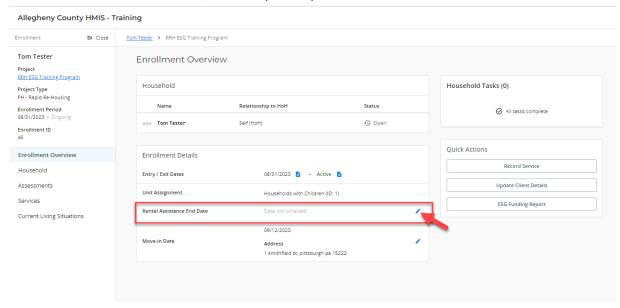




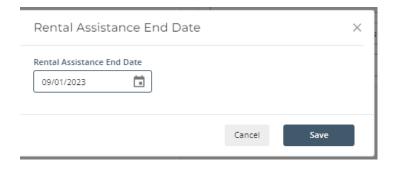
Navigate to the Enrollments screen. Select the name of the household and/or client to navigate to their Enrollment Details screen.



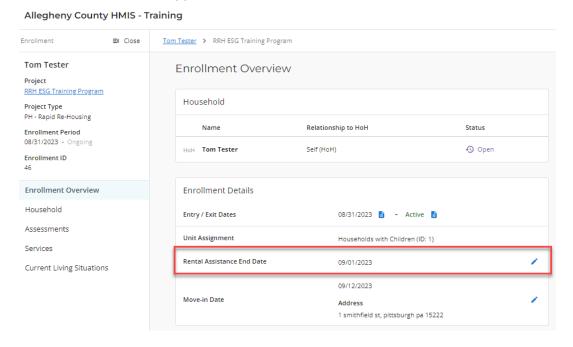
On the Enrollment Details screen, click the pencil symbol next to the Rental Assistance End Date:
